

DISTRICT VOCATIONAL SERVICE CHAIR

ROLE:

To serve as the District liaison assisting Rotary Club members upon request, in the identification, prioritization, planning, implementation and evaluation of Vocational Service Projects.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

To develop, recruit speakers and facilitate the Vocational Service training component at the District Training(s) and District Assembly

To become familiar with model vocational service projects being conducted in the clubs in our District and identify Rotarians who could serve as mentors for other clubs interested in similar projects.

To assist Club Vocational Service Chairs as requested, in their training, program logistics and problem solving efforts as needed.

To assist at other District activities as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

You have been a Rotarian in good standing with your club for at least three years

Have lead/organized/participated in multiple community service projects.

Having served as a Vocational Service Chair of your Club is preferred.

Having knowledge of vocational service projects originating from other clubs is also a plus.

TERM OF OFFICE: Three years- at the discretion of the standing District Governor
